- Act as a faithful agent of ACEC Ohio, subordinating the interests of your company to those of the Council
- Avoid any conflict of interest which could compromise your service as a director
- Work cooperatively with other board members to ensure that Council programs and activities are consistent with its Strategic Plan
- Work cooperatively with other board members to ensure the Council is well-managed and has the financial resources required to accomplish its goals and objectives

(For Chapter representatives)

• Report regularly to the Chapter you represent regarding the board's deliberations and communicate the activities and concerns of members of the Chapter to the Board of Directors

Qualifications: Ideally the board member should be a principal, shareholder or high-level manager in his or her company.
