# Breakout session 1: Bridging the Gap: Strategies for Effective Study-to-Design Handoffs

Transitioning from study to design isn't always seamless — gaps in analysis, documentation, or coordination during the study phase can lead to costly delays and redesigns during design and construction. In this interactive session, attendees will work in small group roundtables to tackle real-world case studies by identifying key challenges, their impacts, and strategies to prevent and resolve them. Through discussion and shared insights, participants will gain proactive approaches to mitigate risks and keep projects on track through better study development.

## **Breakout Session 4: Quality Under Pressure**

As the demand for faster project delivery increases, both ODOT and ACEC member firms face growing challenges and increased pressure to deliver infrastructure projects on accelerated timelines. Whether driven by funding constraints, political priorities, or urgent infrastructure needs, accelerated project timelines can lead to unintended consequences that can impact project quality, costs, and execution.

This breakout session will explore the shared obstacles that both ODOT and ACEC firms encounter when schedules are compressed, including design quality risks, resource strain, and maintaining the QA/QC process. We will examine how these challenges affect both ODOT and consultants, discussing examples and the long-term implications for Ohio's transportation projects.

Through an interactive panel discussion, attendees will gain insights into best practices for mitigating these obstacles, including proactive communication, a joint QA/QC process understanding, and usage of "over the shoulder" reviews. Participants will leave with a clearer understanding of how to balance speed with quality, ensuring that Ohio's infrastructure projects remain both efficient and effective under time constraints.
