ACEC Ohio's PAC year ends on December 31, 2024, and there's still time to meet your company's PAC goal! The ACEC Ohio PAC has met 59% of our \$55,000 goal and 40% of our \$55,000 National PAC goal. Thank you to the 51-member companies that have met their 2024 PAC goal!

State lawmakers and regulators make decisions every day that impact how Ohio's engineering companies do business. The ACEC Ohio Political Action Committee exists for the sole purpose of ensuring that the people making these decisions understand the perspective of the owners of private engineering companies. Donations to ACEC Ohio/PAC are used to support the election campaigns of legislators and state officials who recognize and support the interests of our industry.

ACEC Ohio continues to build strong relationships with elected officials that are supportive of our business interests. By developing these relationships, ACEC Ohio has:

- Passed a bill to regulate the use of indemnity provisions in public contracts.
- Passed a lien bill for design professionals.
- Supported new water/wastewater funding for Ohio as part of the ARPA funds.
- Pushed for additional dollars for the Ohio BUILDS program.
- Protected professional licensure standards and qualifications-based selection in the Ohio Revised Code.
- Supported record capital bill funding for facility funding in Ohio.
- Oppose any reduction in the motor vehicle user fee.
